

## HMI Alumni Leadership Trip June 2-6, 2024

We are thrilled to announce the launch of this inaugural **HMI Alumni Leadership Trip to Israel**, offering a unique opportunity for our dedicated alumni to revisit the place that sparked your Honeymoon Israel journey and deepen your commitment to HMI through leadership and support.

The Alumni Leadership Trip will feature opportunities for alumni to hear diverse viewpoints from experts and leaders in Israel, experience meaningful volunteer opportunities, and forge deeper connections with other passionate alumni across the nation. You will also have the opportunity to dive deeper into your thinking about being a leader in the Jewish community and the role we all play as leaders at critical times.

Following the tragic events of October 7, Israel and the Jewish community are forever changed. As an alum, you have the unique opportunity to become a valuable leader in the HMI community and join us on this journey of resilience and renewal.

This trip is open to all HMI alumni as individuals, but both partners from a couple are welcome to apply individually. Potential participants will each complete a short application, describing their interest in the trip and in deeper engagement with HMI as an alum leader. To participate in this program, we kindly request a two year minimum gift commitment of \$1,800 per year as well as opportunities for further engagement within the organization and the broader Jewish community.







## **Trip Details**

This trip will take place from **Sunday**, **June 2 - Thursday**, **June 6**, **2024**.

- Participants must arrive in Israel by Sunday, June 2, at 2:00 pm and the program will end Thursday evening after dinner at 8:00 pm.
- This group will be based out of Tel Aviv and Jerusalem for the duration of the trip.
- If you would like to extend your stay through Shabbat, we can work with you to help secure accommodations.
- You must have a passport with an expiration date beyond six months of the trip dates.

## Costs

This program is highly subsidized thanks to the generosity of donors.

- \$500 participation fee per person; this includes hotel in double occupancy, most meals, and transportation throughout the program.
- If you wish to stay in a single room, there will be a single supplement room cost of an additional \$500.
- This cost does not include flights or airport transfers - participants must book their own flight arrangements and travel to/from both their home airport and the airport in Israel
- We recommend all participants get travel insurance.

## **Paying It Forward to HMI**

Meaningful gifts to Honeymoon Israel ensure that we can continue our important work connecting couples to Israel and Jewish life, and sustaining our ever growing community.

- We ask that each household, whether an individual or couple, commits to a minimum gift to Honeymoon Israel of \$1,800 for two years (2024 and 2025).
